Sub: Application to start a new Homoeopathic Medical College namely, Shri Barani Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Pillakamedu, Kokkarayanpettai, Thiruchengode, Namakkal, Tamil Nadu-638007 with intake capacity of 100 seats in BHMS course for the academic session 2021-22 under section 12A of HCC Act, 1973 LoI – reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to your application dated 30/09/2020 received from the Ministry through its letter No.R-14012/8/2020-EP-II dated 27.10.2020 and to say that the proposal has been considered in this Medical Assessment and the Rating Board.

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy.

2. As inspection was conducted on 27.10.21 to verify the fulfillment of conditions mentioned in Letter of Intent dated 06.10.2021 and as per the inspection report the college is fulfilling all the requirements of section 12A of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013, the competent authority has decided to issue **Letter of Permission (LoP) to start new Homoeopathic Medical College namely Shri Barani Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Pillakamedu, Kokkarayanpettai, Thiruchengode, Namakkal, Tamil Nadu-638007 under section 12A of HCC Act, 1973 from the academic session 2021-22.**

3. All admissions in Under Graduate and Post graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

4. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

5. The college has to comply with the full requirements of Minimum Standard Requirement Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course.
